

The Robert F. Young, Jr. Memorial Scholarship

This **Full Scholarship** for the study of digital photography at M.A.R.S. was established in 2004 in honor of professional photographer Robert F. Young, Jr. of Silver Spring, Md.

Robert Young Jr's distinguished career spanned more than fifty years and included executive portraiture, photojournalism, commercial photography and service as a Navy photographer aboard the USS Pocono. While working as the University Photographer at Georgetown University, Washington, D.C., Young photographed U.S. Presidents, heads of state, world leaders and entertainers for release to worldwide and local media. Robert was also responsible for establishing the Photographic Communications Consortium for professional photographers working in the Washington, D.C. area.

Young's family, as an appropriate memorial to Robert's passion for the emerging art of digital photography and his interest in helping fellow professional photographers, selected the **Robert F. Young Jr. Memorial Scholarship** to M.A.R.S. for the study of digital photography.

This is a **scholarship for full tuition** and includes room (single occupancy) and all scheduled meals to the MARS 2012 Session. It will be awarded each year to a worthy candidate.
